
又见五台山剧院

又见五台山剧院是导演和建筑师紧密合作的成果,使得表演和建筑在艺术层面融为一体。 《又见五台山》剧目回应佛学主题,希望人们重新审视一生、一年、一天、一瞬间、一轮回, 从中体味人生的价值,感知佛法的智慧。

剧场的主体是 72m×120m×24m 的矩形 体量,为打破建筑固有的边界,从建筑主体向 前广场延续出连续七折的墙体,宛若徐徐拉开 的经折,巧妙地化解了大型建筑体量对于自然 环境的压迫感,形成没有边际之感的建筑。经 折墙共七折,取义"七级浮屠",暗示人修行成 佛的七个层次,每个折院中设主题预演区,将 游客在观赏表演过程中,不知不觉引导至演艺 中心主入口,游客的观演情绪达到高潮。





Encore Mount Wutai, a theatre, is the product of a joint effort of the opera director and the architect, which witnessed the artistic combination of performance and architecture. The repertoire Encore Mountain Wutai employed themes of Buddhism, hoping people will reflect on their life journey or a year, a day, a moment and one reincarnation to appreciate the value of life and the wisdom of the teachings of Buddha.

The main structure of the theatre is a rectangular volume of 72m×120m×24m. In order to break the inherent boundaries of the building, the architect designed a series of zigzagging walls in seven-folds, imitating the unfolding Scriptures, extended from the building to the plaza in the front and forming a space without boundary, which smartly released the visual pressure of a large-scale building on the nature. The design of the seven-folds wall was borrowed from the idea of a pagoda of seven stories, indicating the seven levels of enlightenment. Each yard in the folds has a different rehearsal theme, and the climax arrived when visitors were unconsciously led to the main entrance fold by fold when enjoying the play in different yards.
